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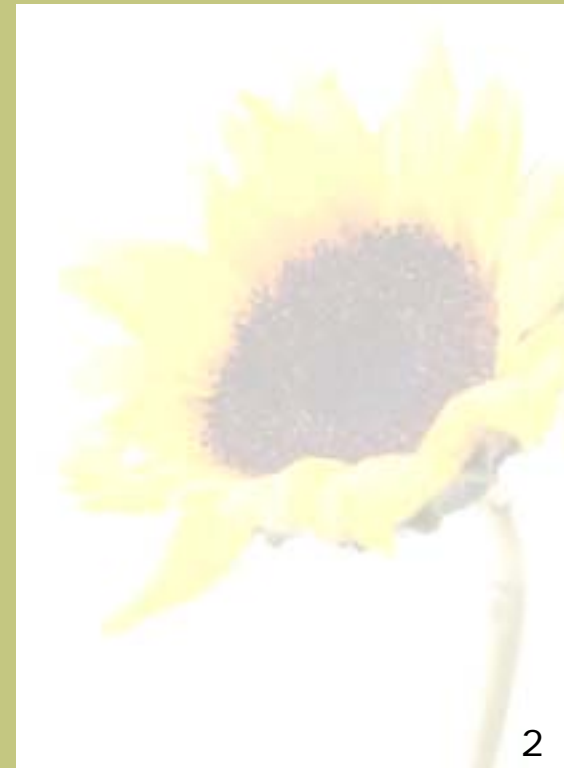

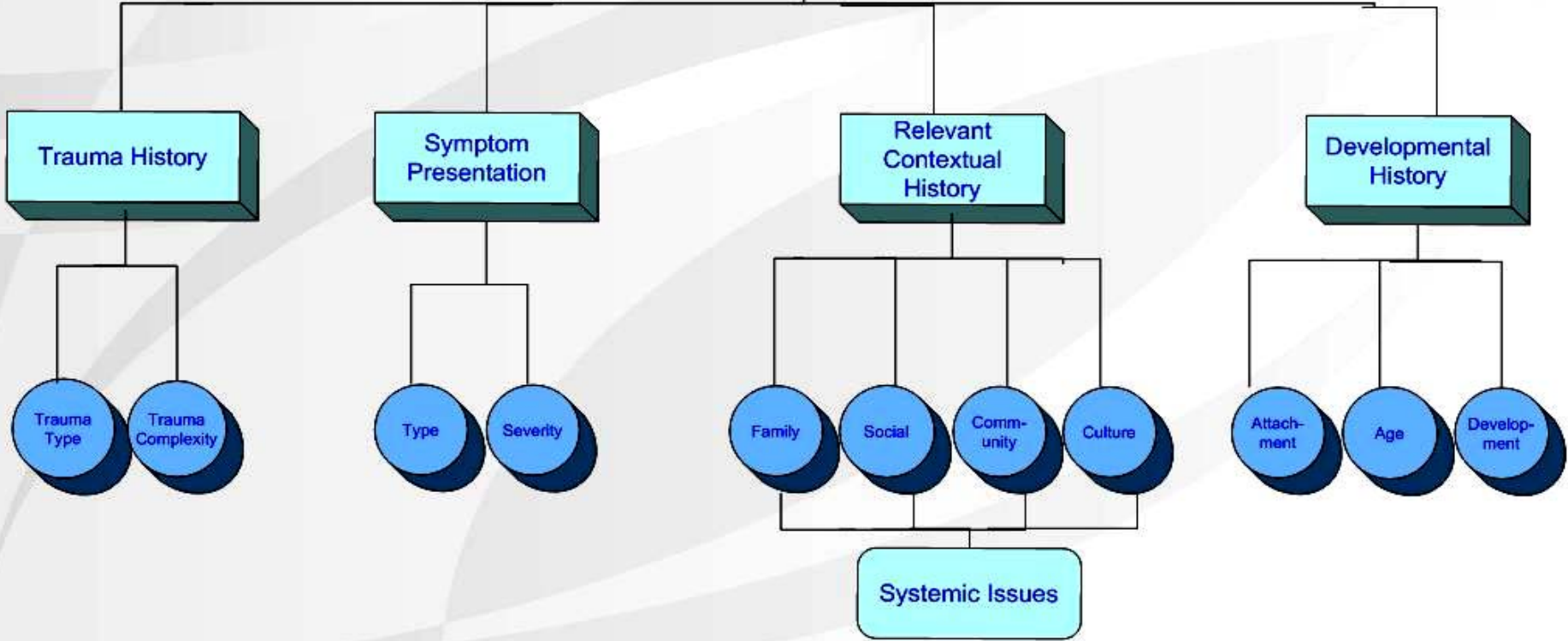
4 Components of TAP

1. Assessment
2. Creating a Unique Client Picture
3. Triage
4. Treatment



Unique Client Picture

Completion of Standardized Measures and Clinical Interview



How to form your Clinical hypothesis

- Consider all assessment feedback
- Which family members need to be included in treatment?
What are the dynamics in the family?
- Family and client buy in
- Consider the cause of distress

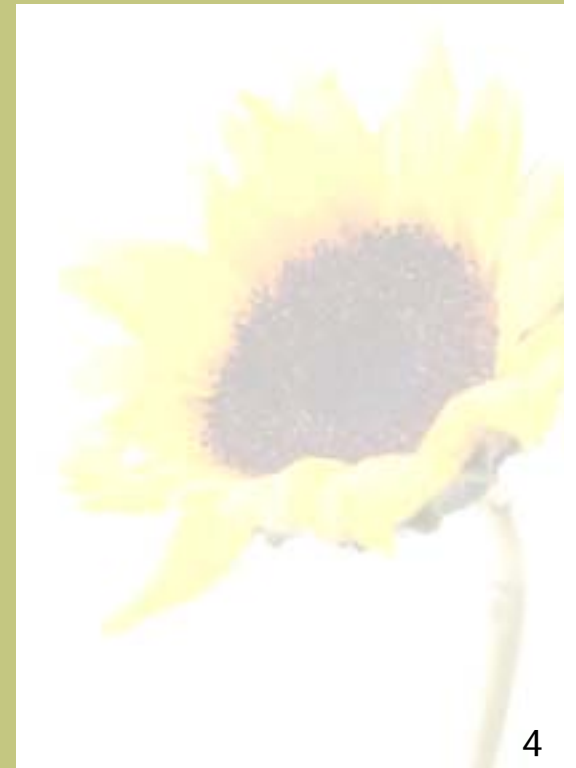
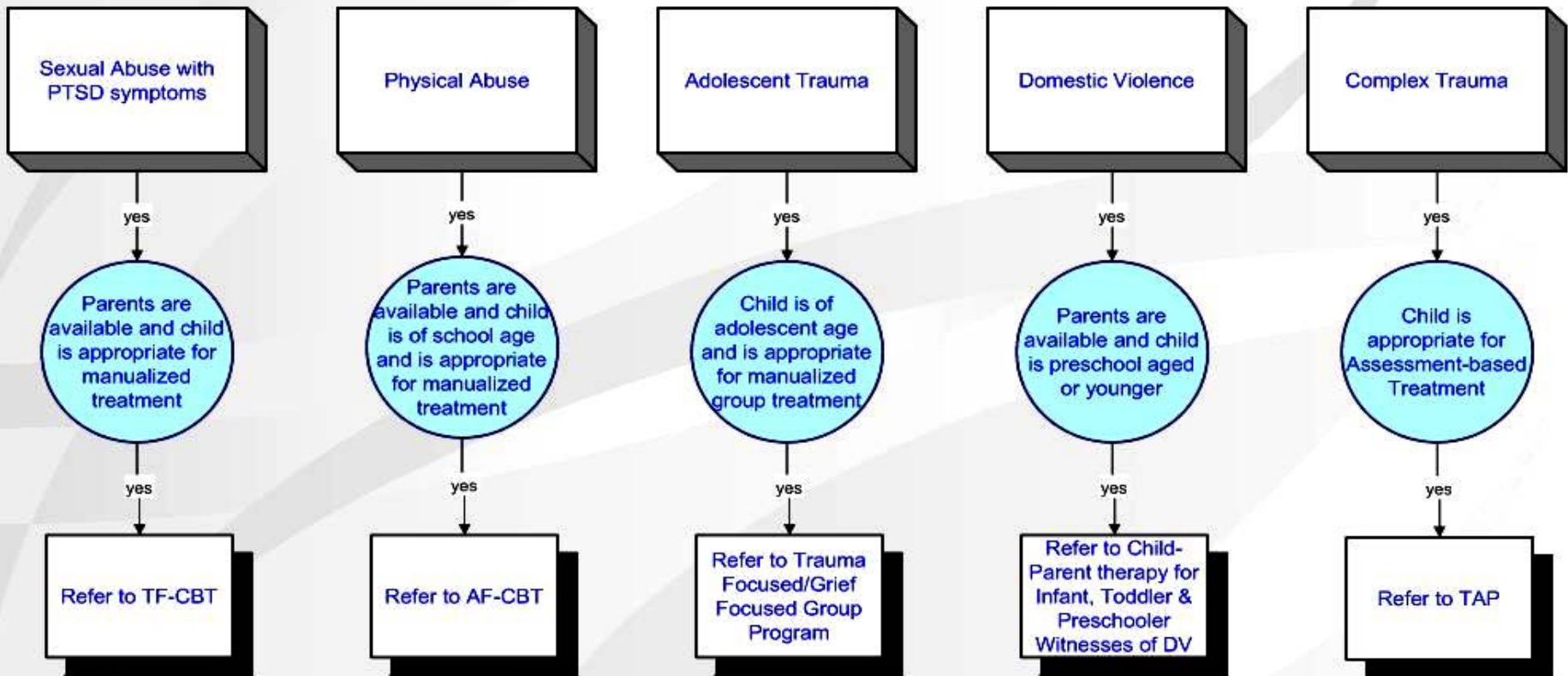
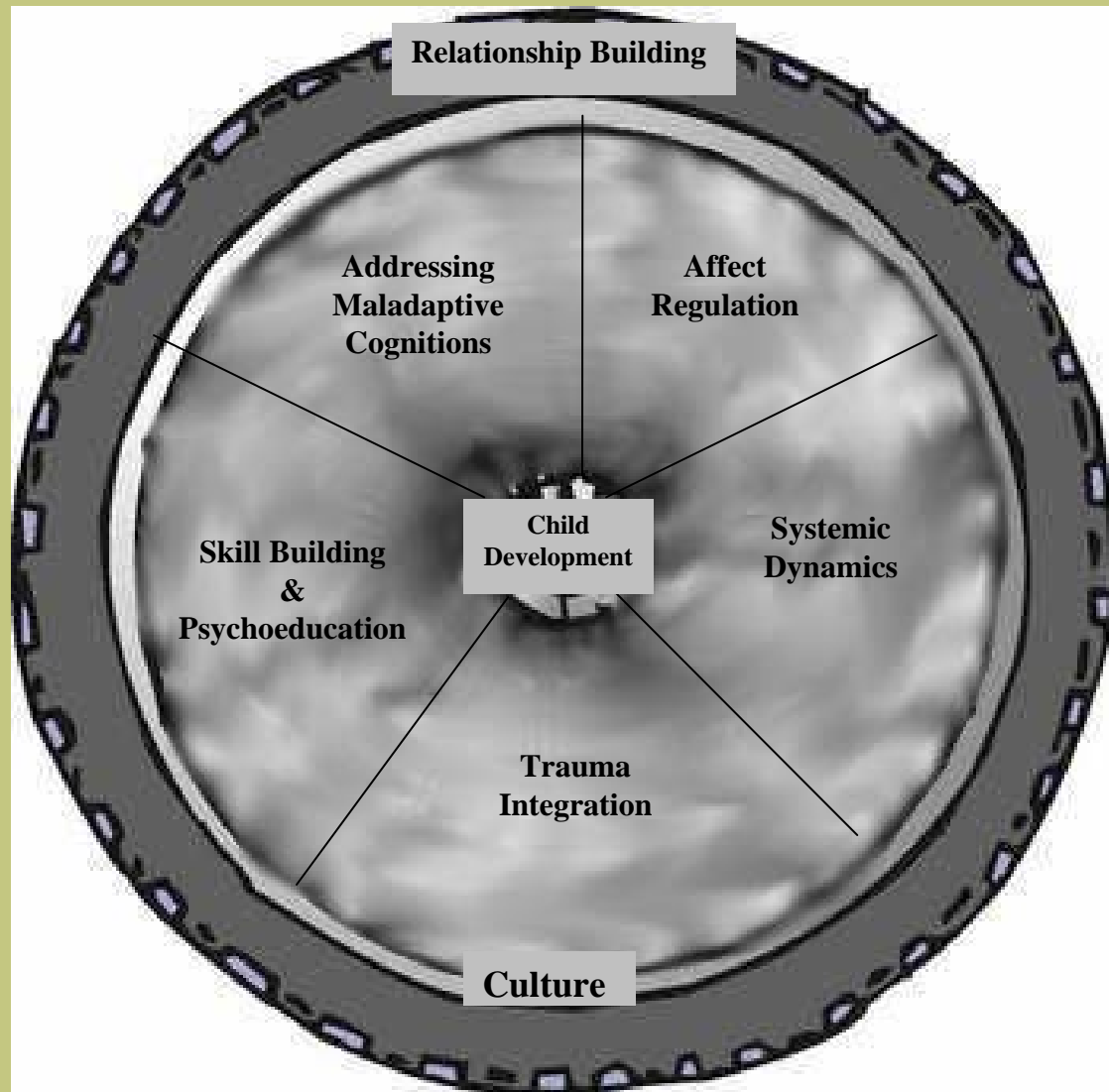


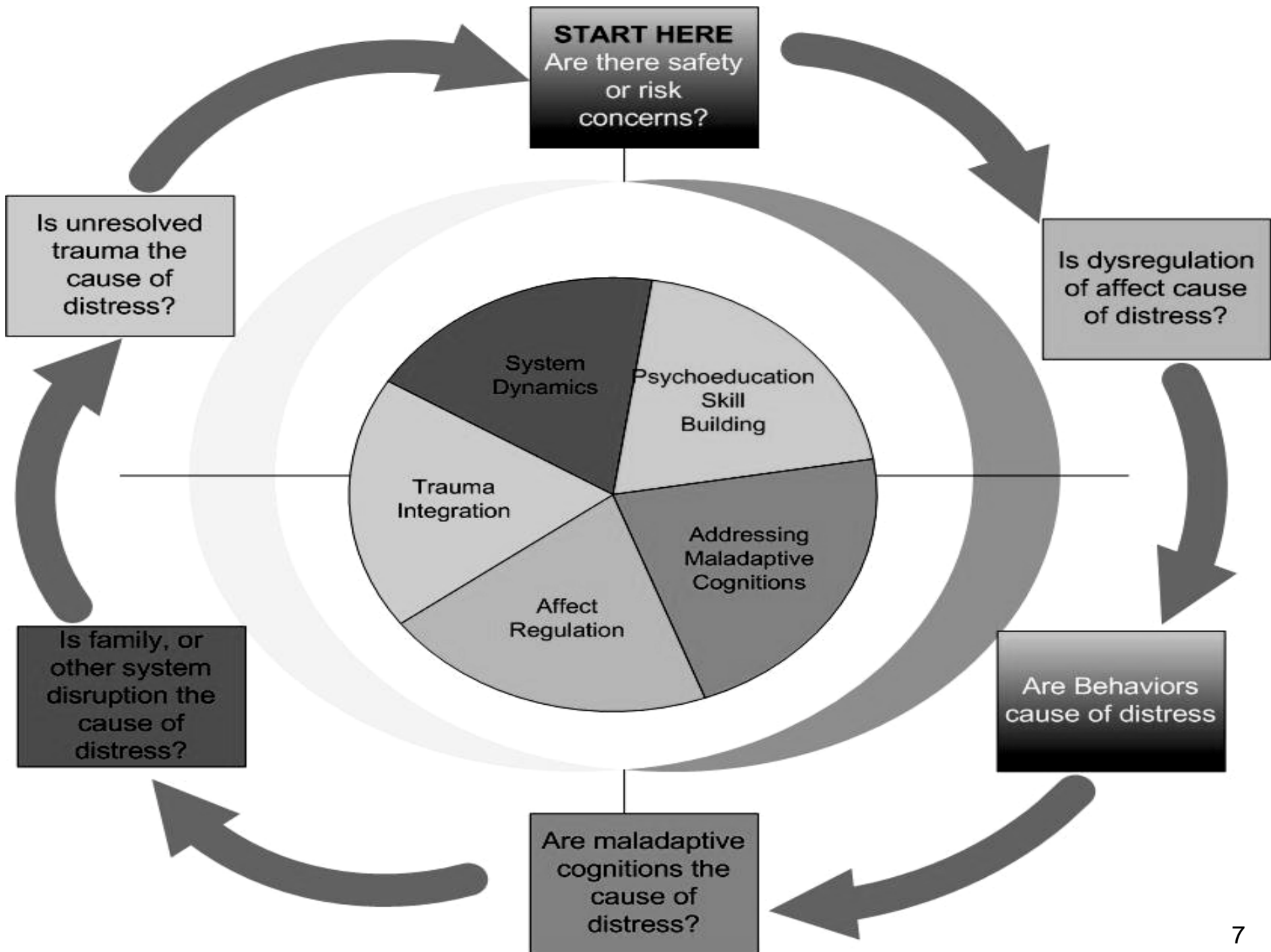

Trauma Specific Referrals



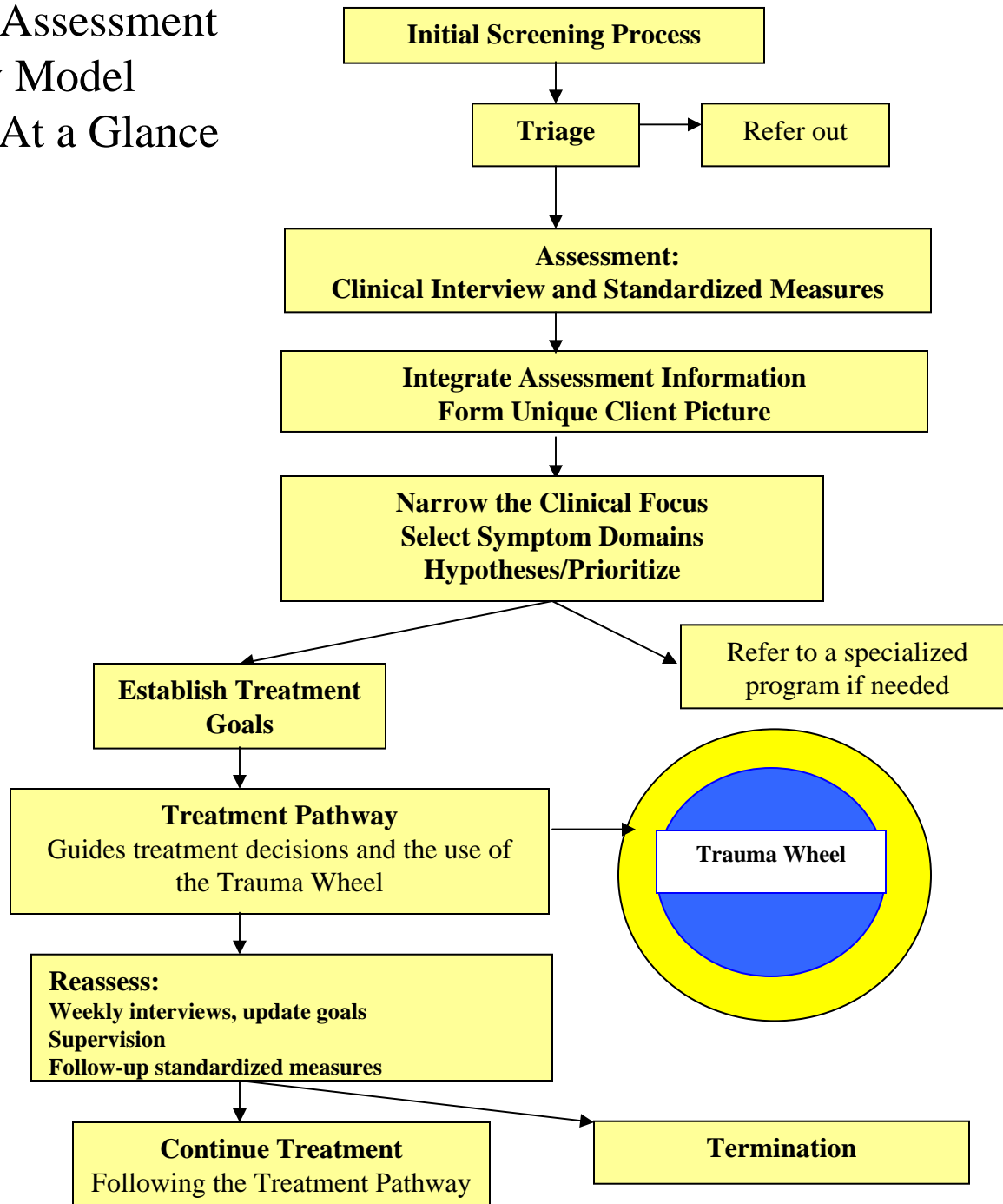
NOTE: The TAP model can be used in addition to other models or as the clinical pathway directs .
